NELSON'S JOURNEY PURPLE PICNIC







CHOCOLATE FUDGE CAKE

This simple chocolate cake is made to the same recipe that my mum used when I was a child and it's what I always bake if I want a nice cake that doesn't take long to make. It makes a great addition to a picnic as the fudge icing sets fairly hard which makes it much easier to pack and transport.

Approximately 12 slices.

TAKE

225g soft unsalted butter or baking spread 225g caster sugar

- 4 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
 - 175g self raising flour 50g cocoa powder
- 2 teaspoons baking powder

CHOCOLATE FUDGE ICING

75g unsalted butter 4 tablespoons cocoa powder 225g icing sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

COOKING INSTRUCTIONS

- Pre-heat the oven to 160°C (fan oven)
- Lightly grease two 21cm loose bottomed cake tins with butter and
- 3 Beat the soft unsafted butter (or baking spread) in a large bowl with an electric hand held mixer until pale and light (almost like a mayonnaise like consistency)
- Measure the caster sugar into a measuring jug and gradually add to the butter whilst continuing to beat. Stop occasionally to scrape the mixture back down the sides of the bowl with a silicone scraper.
- Break the large free range eggs into a jug and beat lightly with a fork.
 - Measure the self raising flour, cocoa powder and baking powder into a medium sized bowl and combine with a dry whisk.
- 7 Gradually add the beaten eggs to the butter and sugar mixture whilst continuing to beat followed by the vanilla extract. As you get to the final few additions add a tablespoon of the measured flour each time to

- Sift the remaining self raising flour and cocoa powder into the mixture then fold in using a large metal mixing spoon.
- Divide the mixture equally between the tins. Bake the cakes on the middle shelf of the pre-heated oven for 20 25 minutes until they spring back when you press them and a metal skewer comes out clean when inserted into the cake.
- O Allow the cakes to cool for 5 minutes before loosening the edges with a round bladed krife and then removing. Leave to cool completely on a wire rack.
- 11 To make the icing melt the butter in a medium sized saucepan over a gentle heat
- 12 Stir in the cocoa powder, icing sugal milk and vanilla extract.
- Continue to stir over the gentle hea until the icing is smooth and glossy.
- 14 Pour half the warm icing over the bottom layer of the cake and candwich the too layer on
- 5 Pour the remaining icing over the top of the cake.
- Leave to set.

My grandmother was an enthusiastic cook however she was quite rebellious and almost always refused to follow a recipe. These jars full of deliciousness have been created in her memory as they are more of a concept than a recipe and they are perfect for anyone that doesn't really like following instructions!

My "naughty nanny" as she was affectionately known used to make us eat our pudding before our main course in case we would be too full up to manage it! My grandmother was very partial to a glacé cherry and always carried a KitKat in her handbag in case of emergencies.

The idea is that you layer up your loved ones or your own favourite treats in a screw top jar and then eat your way through the layers of memories that they evoke.

- Include some layers of wet ingredients like cream, custard or yoghurt to help bring everything together
- You could make a frozen version using icecream

My jar in memory of my grandmother Lucy was layered with her favourites.

Whipped double cream

Fresh sliced strawberries

Raspberries

Blueberries

Tinned peaches

Broken shortbread biscuits

Smashed meringues

All topped off with a KitKat and a glacé cherry

Once you've put all your layers of treats in your jar put on the lid and leave it in the fridge so the flavours have a chance to meld together a bit.


