Few people could have predicted that the birth of Nelson's Journey in 1997 would lead to the lives of thousands of bereaved children in Norfolk being transformed for the better. After years of successful growth, our charity now supports several hundred children each year, helping each of them to see their lives and futures positively.

Whilst the number of bereaved children that we are supporting each year continues to grow, the complexity of the cases which we are supporting has also increased. As well as growing our capacity to help more children, an important part of our strategy is investing in the continuing professional development of our fantastic staff and volunteers and ensuring that our services are always based on need.

Throughout our 20th anniversary, we will be celebrating our impact in the community and the important milestones in our history, such as: moving into our own home in 2014; launching the world's first interactive smartphone app to support bereaved children in 2016; and the soon to be announced launch of another innovative project developed by our dedicated Youth Panel.

We are a forward looking charity, and we will celebrate our anniversary with our future impact in mind. The Twenty20 initiative is a vital part of the next step on our journey, and throughout our anniversary celebrations we are looking forward to working with those who are seeking to leave a legacy of smiles.

Meet Harley

In 2015 Harley's Grandad died suddenly of a heart attack. The impact of his death had a significant impact on the whole family but particularly Harley. Sonya is his Mum and shares their story:

One of the hardest things I have ever had to do is tell my son that his Grandad had died. At that point, his heart broke, he screamed, he cried, he shook, he hit himself, he wouldn't talk and he didn't understand. And my heart shattered. The worst pain in life is seeing your child broken and not being able to put the pieces back together – I didn't even know where to start let alone how to. How on earth can you explain to the person you love most in the world something that you don't even understand yourself?

Harley received well meaning advice from close friends including someone saying "when you all die you will be together again, you will see him again then". Shortly after this Harley declared he "wanted to run out of school and in front of a car so he could die to see Grandad again".

At this point I knew we needed additional support. One of the mums at school who had sadly been through the same suggested I contact Nelson's Journey. I rang them that day and spoke to a Child Bereavement Support Worker. It was an emotional phone call and I remember him saying something like "I promise you there is not one child who has been to us who hasn't been helped, it's what we do, it's what we are here for - we help children in these situations".

And not only did he deliver what he promised and far, far more besides, but he gave me back the one thing I never thought I could have again, a son that smiled and laughed and had hopes and good dreams again. Nelson's Journey gave Harley his future back.

For all their time, their support, their kindness, the fun and the generosity I will never, ever, ever be able to thank them.

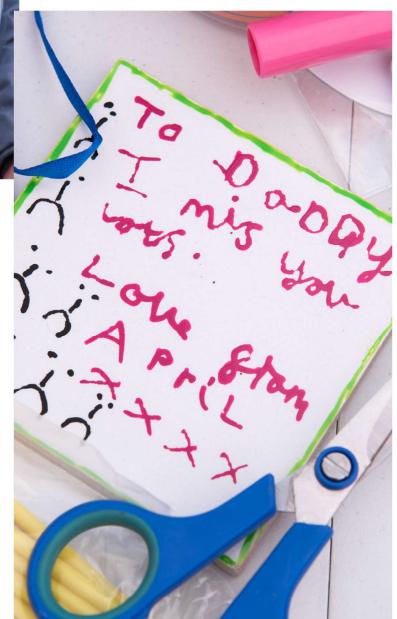
The Twenty20 will be an exclusive group of businesses all working towards the same aim, of raising at least £1,000 each in support of bereaved children and young people.
