> ☆ Put the bricks together and you can create your own wall – anywhere that suits you.


If you are looking to raise funds for Nelson's Journey you could ask people to pay a £1 or £2 for a brick and the memory wall could be shown at your fundraising event

We hope that you enjoy reading about all the special memories others share.



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
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
